Peter Colvin is assistant librarian at the School of Oriental and African Studies (SOAS), University of London, since 1973, and Secretary of MELCOM (UK). A forthcoming publication is a handlist of early Egyptian printed books in the SOAS Library.

Graham Jefcoate is head of Early Printed Collections at the British Library. Formerly he was research analyst within the British Library Research and Innovation Centre and a contributor to the ESTC Project. He served as honorary secretary of the Library Association Library History group from 1990 to 1997, and secretary of the Historic Libraries Forum from 1992 to 1994. His publications include a catalogue of English books printed before 1801 held by the University Library of Göttingen, and he has published widely on library history and the Anglo-German book trade links in the eighteenth century.

Hildegard Müller has been director of the University Library of Luneberg, Germany, since 1995. She is a member of the Verein Deutscher Bibliothekare and of the Wolfenbuttlter Arbeitskreis für Bibliotheksgeschichte. Publications include *Liberale Press im badischen Vormarx* (Heidelberg, 1986).

M. J. Pollock is librarian of the Royal Asiatic Society, London. He was formerly at the British Library Oriental and Indian Office Collections.

Geoffrey Roper is Islamic bibliographer at Cambridge University Library and an historian of Arabic printing and publishing. He has been the editor of *Index Islamicus* since 1982, and served as editor for *World Survey of Islamic Manuscripts*, London, from 1992 to 1994.
